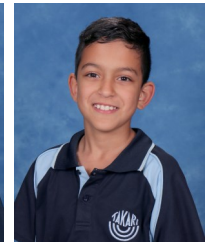

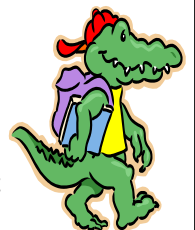
INTERSCHOOL CROSS COUNTRY: The Interschool Cross Country event will be held next Friday 22 June. The event will be held at the Pinnacles and will involve Year 4 to 6 students. A list of competitors will be placed on the noticeboard in the undercover area on Monday. Selected students will be given a permission note to be returned by Wednesday. The first races will involve Year 4 students and is timetabled to start at 1.20pm. Competitors need to wear their blue coloured Takari shirt and appropriate shoes. They will also need their own drink bottle.


