Notes from the Music Teacher

Our Year 5 and Year 6 Rock Bands and the combined schools SCY Band are going to be performing in the WAGSMS (Western Australian Government Schools Music Society) Concert this year at the Crown Theatre. The concert series runs over several nights and we have been assigned the evening of Wednesday 31 July – Week 2 of Term 3.

Tickets for all Crown Theatre Perth concerts are on sale now. Tickets are on a first in best seats basis. There is no limit to the number of tickets that can be purchased per transaction. Concerts have "Sold Out" in the past so to guarantee your attendance, early ticket purchase is recommended.

The ticket price is \$28.00 per ticket for 2019. There is no student or pensioner concession on the ticket price. Children under the age of 2 years are admitted free but must not occupy a seat (they must remain on the lap of a parent or guardian at all times).

Phone: Ticketmaster on 136 100 (call centre opening hours Mon to Sat 7am – 6pm)

In Person: Crown Theatre Box Office, between 9am-5pm Monday-Friday

Please note for online, phone or mobile bookings a 1.95% credit card fee will be charged at time of purchase. A handling fee of \$8.35 will also apply per transaction (not per ticket). To avoid these fees, we suggest you purchase your tickets in person at the Crown Theatre box office. Parents/Schools can organise a group booking to assist with the cost of the handling fee. There are both free and paid options for ticket delivery.

Wheelchair and/or special needs tickets can only be purchased over the phone on 1300 446 925. This is a dedicated Ticketmaster line for these types of bookings only. Requests must be made at time of booking as changes cannot be made after the transaction has been processed. Should concerts not be "sold out" tickets will be available to purchase online and at the box office at Crown up until the Concerts commence.

AFTER SCHOOL DRUM CLUB: Mrs Campione has organised an after school drum club next term for interested Yr 3 to Yr 6 students. An introduction to the type of drumming being taught was given at last week's assembly. 



WORLD OF MATHS INCURSION: Last fortnight, students from Pre-Primary to Year 6 were challenged with a variety of games that tested their creativity and problem solving skills. The mathematical games were related to real life situations involving measurement, logical thinking and sequencing. Students worked in small groups and shared their ideas on how best to solve the mathematical problems. It was great to see students enjoying working together as these cooperative learning activities help develop confidence and communication skills.

Positive Behaviour Support



Takari is entering its second year as a Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) school. The PBS program looks at key behaviour expectations and how these expectations are explicitly taught, modelled and recognised in all areas and aspects of the school.

Staff, students and parents were consulted last year before choosing our four key behaviours of **Respect**, **Responsibility**, **Kindness** and **Personal Best**. A leadership team, consisting of eight staff members, meets every second Tuesday 3.15pm to 4.00pm to discuss the continuing implementation of the program. This team, led by Mrs Luckhurst and Mrs Andrews, is currently looking at designing lessons for staff to teach specific behaviours in all classes.

To make this a whole school community program, the leadership team is looking for parent representation. No experience is necessary, you just need enthusiasm and a desire to help our children to be the best they can be.
