## **TERRIFIC TEAM BUILDING**

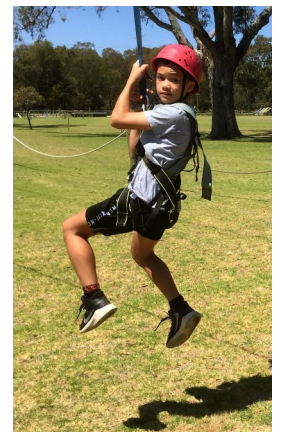
