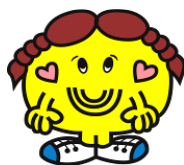

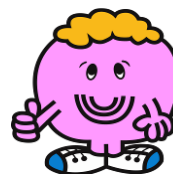
Reading Rendezvous

On Thursday 1 September, we have our Father's Day Stall. There will be gifts available to purchase from \$2 - \$10. Up to 2 gifts per child.

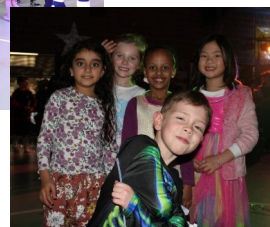
If any parents are able to help run the stall any time between 9am - 11am, please let me know. If we have surplus stock, we will open the stall again on Friday.
