All WA public schools must administer a National School Opinion Survey every two years. These surveys are designed to canvas a range of issues and gain information about most facets of the school's operation. Takari last conducted this survey in 2020, and data from that survey assisted the school with its 50th Anniversary celebrations, the introduction of the Team Takari positive behaviour support program, electronic communications and classroom refreshment program.

Data collected from this year's survey will also be compared with data collected over the last eight years, giving the school a good overall view of its operations. A summary will be provided to the School Council and published in a future newsletter and the 2022 Annual School Report.

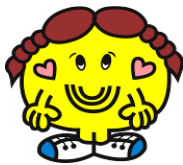

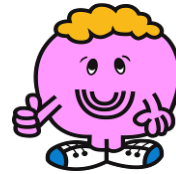
With this in mind, the School Council would like to share that each Takari team member will be presented with an acknowledgement certificate and thank-you letter, which will include the parents' comments.

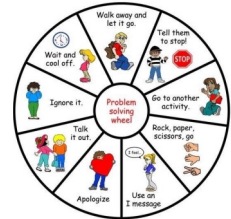
TEAM TAKARI
